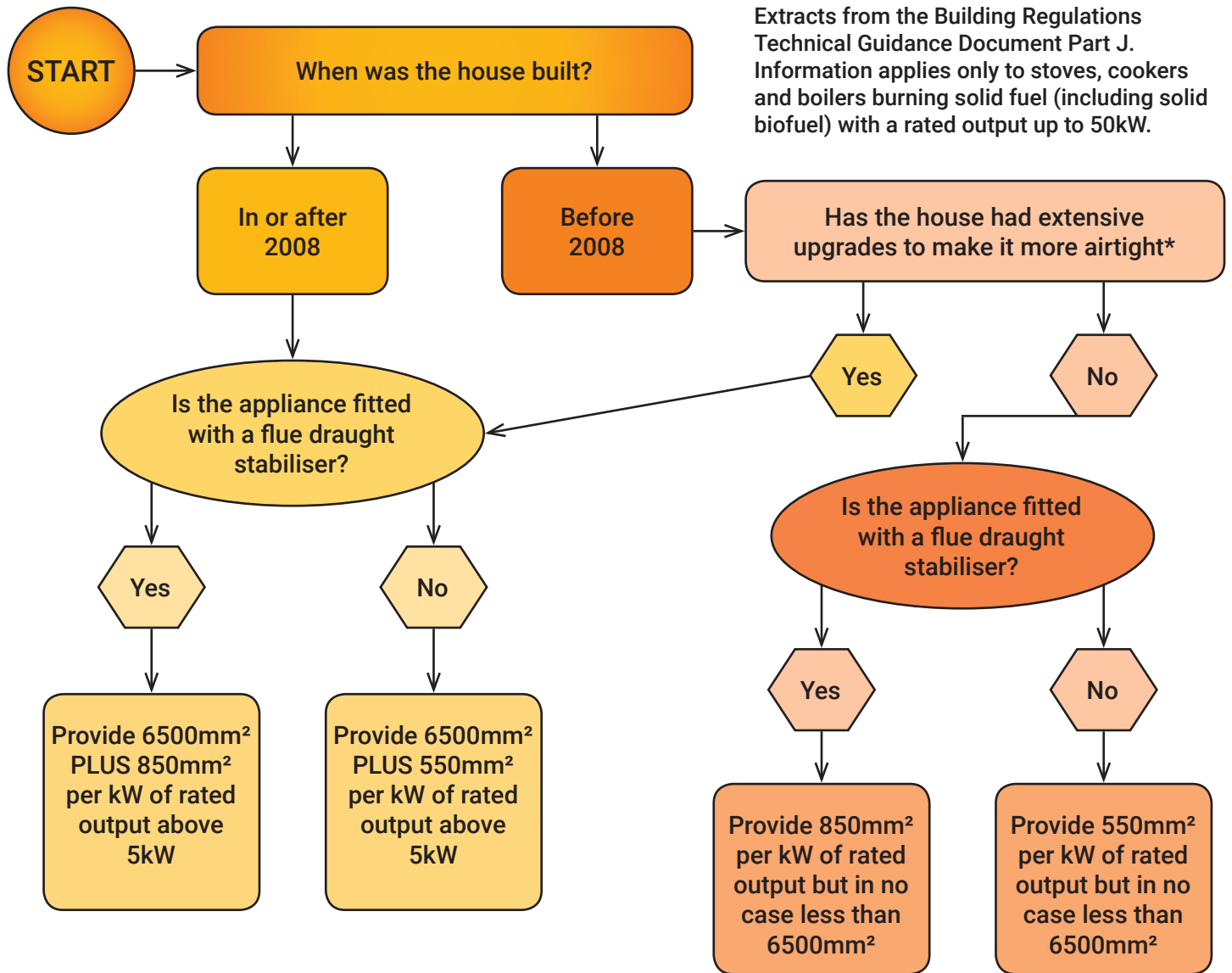


A step by step guide to calculating the ventilation requirements of solid fuel appliances in Ireland



Extracts from the Building Regulations Technical Guidance Document Part J. Information applies only to stoves, cookers and boilers burning solid fuel (including solid biofuel) with a rated output up to 50kW.

- Is it safe to make my own vent using a tube with louvres either side? → No
- Can I use a closeable grille on the inside if I promise to open it when the stove is on? → No
- Can the vent incorporate a flymesh? → No
